THE LOCATION

Spreehalle Berlin is located directly at the Spree and is characterized by its high ceilings and the upper window construction, which transforms the brick building into a special kind of event location flooded with light.

The hall was designed and built around 1910 by the renowned architects Peter Behrens and Ernst Ziesel and was used as a transformer factory of AEG. The later modernization was carried out by an English architectural firm - in collaboration with the musician Bryan Adams.

Spreehalle Berlin is ideal for product presentations, exhibitions, film and video productions as well as for extravagant events, meetings and workshops due to its generous area and bright rooms.

CAPACITY

- Event location on a total of 210 m² + small courtyard
- For a maximum of 200 persons.
- Room dimensions:: 10m x 21m; ceiling height: 7m
